

Dues & Fees

Temple Beth Shalom functions very much as a family whose members decide together how we will all "chip in" to share the costs of creating a vibrant and exciting synagogue with an inspiring staff to serve our community. All members of TBS are of equal importance and are valuable to create our cohesive congregation.

Everyone understands that dues alone will not cover the expenses incurred to carry out our mission as we serve the Jewish Community of our area. We hope that you appreciate the presence of TBS, its rabbi, and its spiritual contribution to Jewish life here in Flagler County. We encourage those wishing to make a larger contribution beyond the basic membership fee to donate to one or more of the funds noted in the ***Donation Opportunities*** section on page 3.

Our fiscal year and dues year begin on June 1st. Dues and fees for members joining mid-year will be prorated.

Associate Membership Dues: Available to those wishing to join TBS who spend no more than 183 days each year in Flagler, St. John's, or Volusia Counties. Classified as *Associate Members*, these congregants pay ½ the dues/fees rate listed. Associate members do not have voting privileges, nor are they eligible for Board positions.

DUES SCHEDULE & PAYMENT OPTIONS

Single payment: Due by July 1

Quarterly payments: Due August 1st, November 1st, February 1st, May 1st

Monthly payments: You have the option to pay by check or to select payment by either Visa, MasterCard or PayPal, on either the 1st or the 15th of each month. Credit card authorization forms are available thru the TBS Office.

There will be first year prorating of building fund and membership assessments.

Associate Membership dues /fees will be calculated at 50% of the regular annual member amount.

Donation Opportunities

At Temple Beth Shalom Palm Coast, there are ample opportunities available, and in need of, your donation(s). While the list below represents some of the existing funding opportunities, it does not reflect the many additional needs of our thriving synagogue. Donations to the **General Fund** are always helpful and always welcome. You may also choose to contribute to one or more of the following:

Oneg & Kiddush Fund: This program provides food and beverages for after Shabbat services on Friday and Saturday. You can sponsor an Oneg in honor or memory of a loved one or life event.

Rabbi's Discretionary Fund: A fund dedicated to the spiritual leader's ability to help those in the Jewish community that are in need. This fund is discrete and will be administered by the rabbi .

Building Fund: Donations to this fund ensure that the ongoing, critically important maintenance needs of both the building and grounds are supported.

Sisterhood Fund: The Sisterhood provides opportunities to strengthen friendship and faith among the women members of the congregation and members of the surrounding Jewish communities of counties through regular social gatherings and special events.

Men's Club Fund: The Men's Club coordinates activities and events that build and encourage camaraderie, as well as sponsoring a variety of fundraising events throughout the year.

Yahrzeit/Memorial Plaques: Our Yahrzeit board provides the opportunity to honor a loved one with a memorial plaque for all to see. The reward lasts lifetimes.

Tree of Life Plaques: For a small donation, you can honor a loved one, a friend, or a life event as a leaf on the Tree of Life, a beautiful wall display donated by the children of Minnie Bubes, In Loving Memory of Phil Bubes.
